How we work with you

Working with Hertfordshire and West Essex ICB to adapt their estate

Sue Fogden, Estates Director at Herts and West Essex ICB shares some of the challenges they're facing and how we're working with them to **improve local healthcare facilities** in their region.

We made an impact through various shared projects including securing **£2.4 million** in Estates and Technology Funds (ETTF) to transform **900sqm of underused space** at Herts and Essex Hospital into a suitable place for **two new GP practices**.

NHSPS were instrumental in helping us adapt our estate so it supported the local community.



Helping Herefordshire and Worcestershire ICB improve how office space is used

We conducted a **strategic review** of Herefordshire and Worcestershire ICB's office buildings which found that the current space wasn't being used efficiently.

Our lease advisory team worked with the ICB to rationalise their office estate and negotiate favourable lease terms for a new purpose-built headquarters – making significant savings for the ICB.
