Background

NHS Property Services funded and coordinated work at Horsham Hospital to modernise the building and create a new musculoskeletal (MSK) unit.

The MSK department at Horsham Hospital is run by Sussex MSK Partnership and treats people with a wide range of muscle, bone and joint conditions, such as arthritis, back pain and sports injuries.

Delivery

15 new treatment rooms have been opened and the seven existing rooms, waiting areas and facilities have all been refurbished. The improvements mean that patients can see a wide range of specialist doctors and therapists all in one visit.

NHS Property Services also took the opportunity to upgrade the rehabilitation gym, commence a programme to replace areas of flooring across the hospital and undertake works to the building infrastructure. The work also included a major renewal of the roof, all of which will improve existing facilities and extend the life of the building.
