Background

The project was commissioned by East Leicestershire and Rutland Clinical Commissioning Group, to provide a purpose built modern facility to integrate a number of health services that were previously located at Market Harborough District Hospital.

Delivery

The construction of the three-storey St Luke's Treatment Centre was coordinated by NHS Property Services and opened to patients in March 2017.

Patients visiting the Treatment Centre are now welcomed into a bright and airy main reception and waiting room and a ground floor that comprises a Minor Injuries Unit; a new X-ray suite, modern physiotherapy facilities and St Luke's Branch Surgery.

The first floor of the building features 20 consulting rooms for outpatient services provided by local NHS healthcare partnership, 'Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland Alliance' and Leicestershire Partnership NHS Trust (LPT), including specially equipped podiatry rooms.

The second floor of the building provides office space for LPT and the Alliance with facilities including hot-desks and staff amenities.
